Why create digital audio for students?

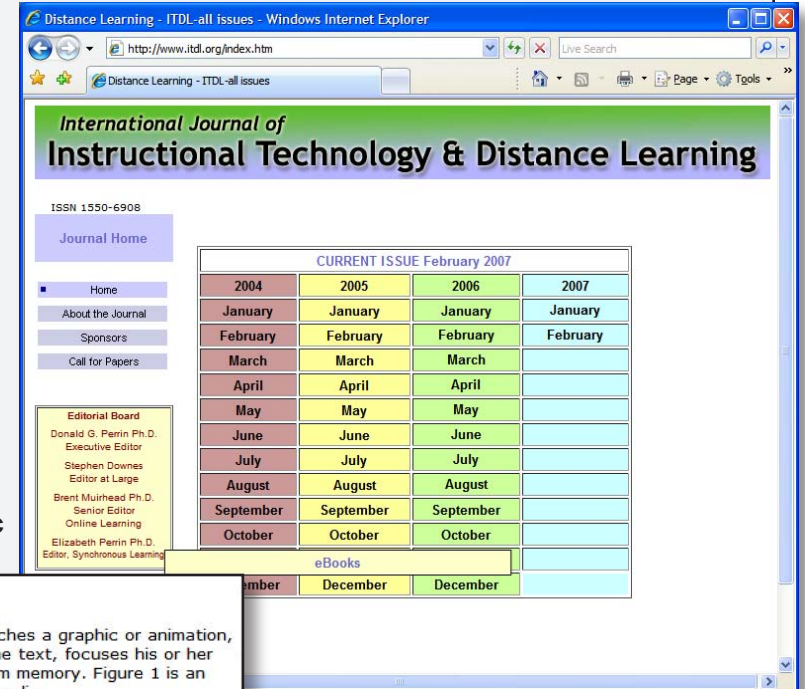
A growing body of research indicates that the addition of audio can significantly improve online learning. The October 2006 issue of the [International Journal of Instructional Technology & Distance Learning](#) contains an article based on this research about the potential impact of multimedia materials made with audio.

The article provides an excellent discussion of how digital audio, when used effectively in multimedia materials, can increase student attention, comprehension, and retention by gradually altering the learner's long-term memory.

Multimedia Learning Graphic

Multimedia Learning

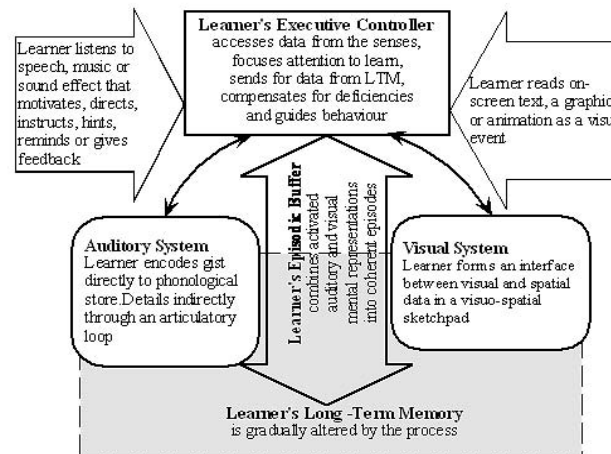


Figure 1. The structure and process of learning from multimedia according to the attentional control definition of multimedia learning.

Learning from multimedia begins when an adult or child watches a graphic or animation, listens to speech, some music or a sound effect, reads some text, focuses his or her attention to learn and send data to and from their long-term memory. Figure 1 is an illustration of the cognitive structure of learning from multimedia.

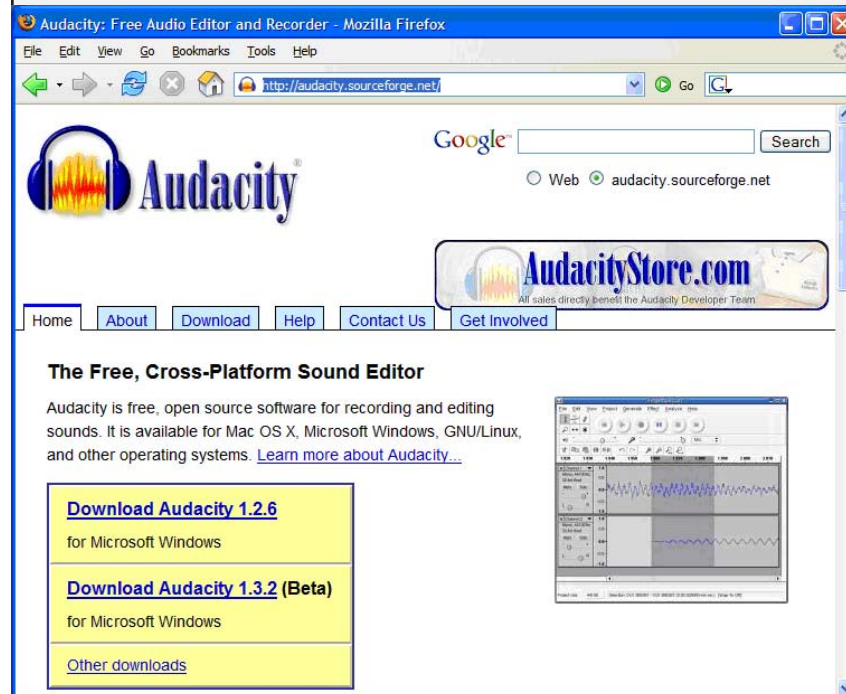
How do you get started? The first step is to download and install a copy of Audacity on your computer. Audacity is a copyright-free program that allows you to create MP3s, an abbreviation for MPEG-Layer 3, a highly compressed audio file that can be easily shared.

To download the latest version of Audacity, an 8.5 MB program, go to <http://audacity.sourceforge.net/>.

Click on “Download Audacity 1.2.6” to access the [Audacity download page](#).

5. Point to **Download Audacity 1.2.6**.

7. Click on **Download Audacity 1.2.6**.

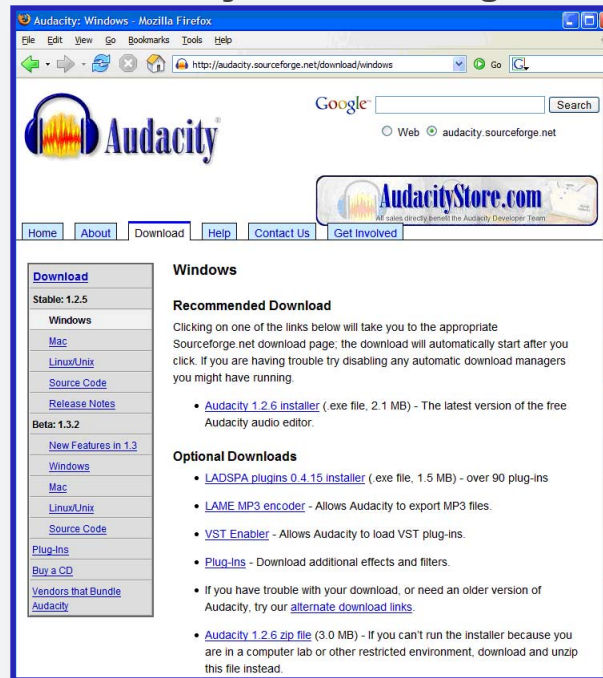
At the download page, first select your computer's operating system. For WebTycho users that will be Windows, which is also the default screen for this page. If the Windows options is not displayed, click on **Windows** in the shaded menu box.

To begin downloading the program, left click [Audacity 1.2.6. Installer](#). You do not need any of the Optional Downloads at this time.

A dialog box will appear. Select the **Save to Disk** option, then click **OK**.

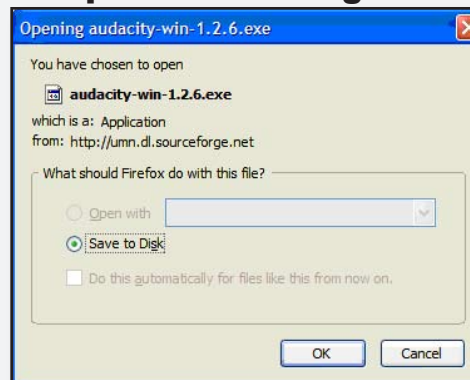

8. Point to [Download](#). Highlight Windows.

9. Point to [Audacity 1.2.6. Installer](#). Left Click.

10. Select Save to Disk.

11. Click **OK**.

Another dialog box will appear asking you to select the location on your computer where you would like save the file. Since this is an installation file, not a program file, select your computer's **Desktop**.

Click **Save** and the installation file will download to your computer.

Browse to your computer's Desktop and locate the **audacity-win-1.2.6-exe file**. Double click to open it.

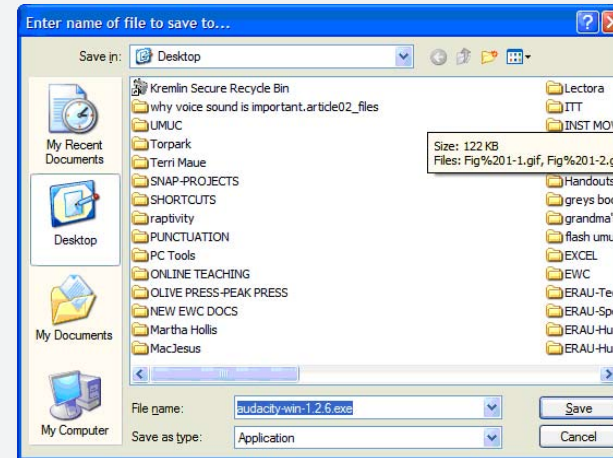
Windows' install wizard will now take you through the process of installing Audacity on your computer.

Click **Next** to begin the installation process.

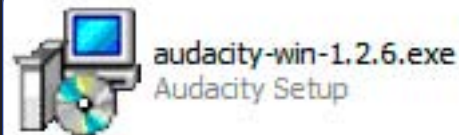

12. Select **Desktop** in drop-down menu.



13. Click **Save**.



14. Double click on **audacity-win-1.2.6-exe** icon on Desktop.

15. **Setup Wizard**.



Click **Next**.

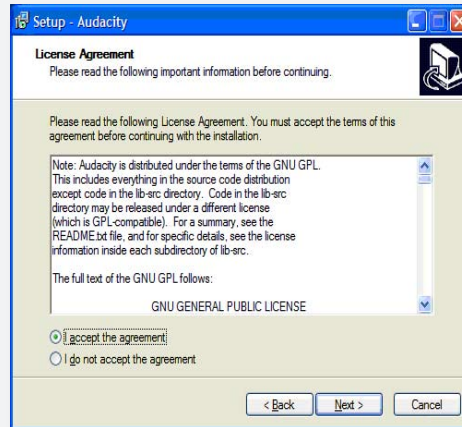
The next screen is GNU's license agreement, which states that Audacity is a free program which you cannot copyright. GNU is a group that distributes free software. Click **I accept the agreement** and then **Next**.

Next you will see a box of general and technical information about the program.

Click **Next** again.

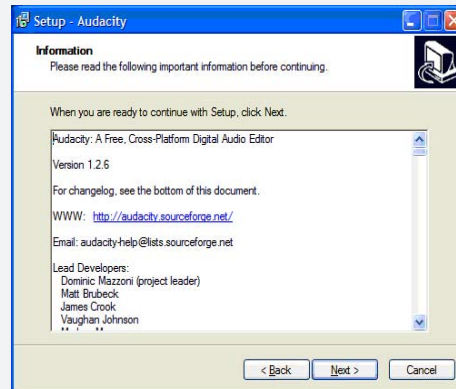

16. Select **I accept the agreement**. Click **Next**.

Now you will be asked to name the folder that will contain the program files. By default you should see: **C:\Program Files\Audacity**. If not, enter those exact words and symbols into the address window. Be sure to use backslashes.

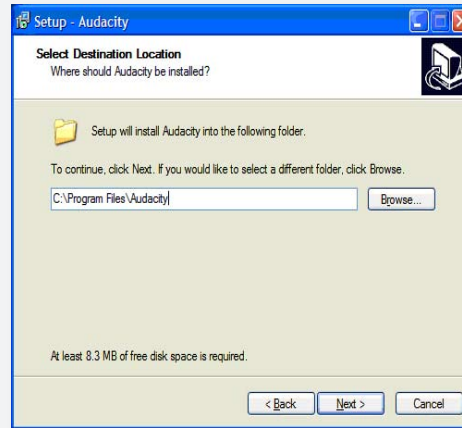
Click **Next**.

You will now see the Additional Tasks dialog box. Click inside both boxes: **Create a Desktop Icon** and **Associate Audacity project files**.

Click **Next**.

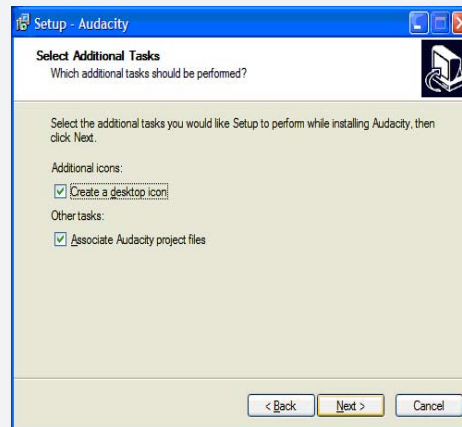

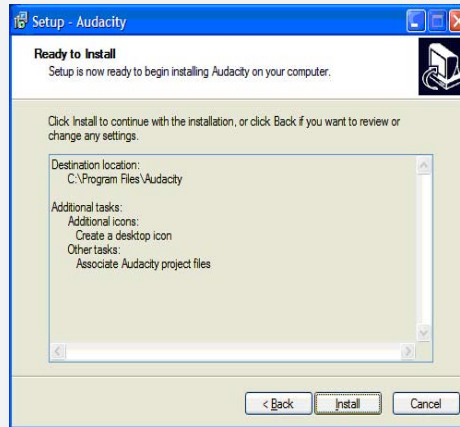
Confirm your destination and additional tasks selections in the next box. Then —

Click **Install**. Wait for the program to install. When it is finished, place a check in the **Launch Audacity** box, then click **Finish**.

Audacity will launch its opening screen and is now ready to record your audio.

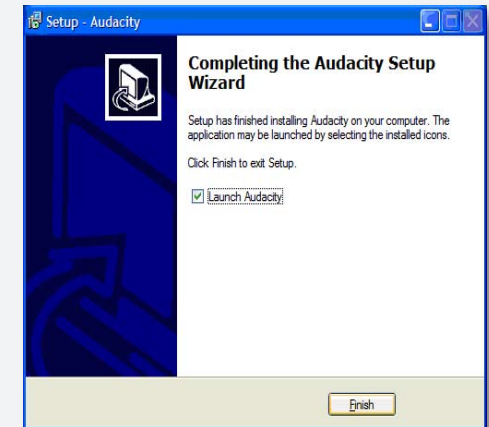

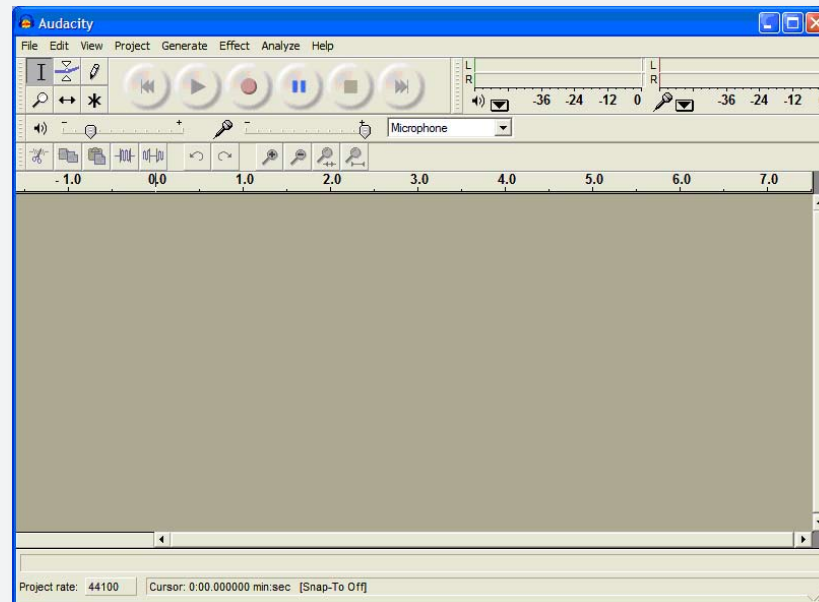

Before recording your first MP3, you may wish to familiarize yourself with some of the Audacity functions and preferences.

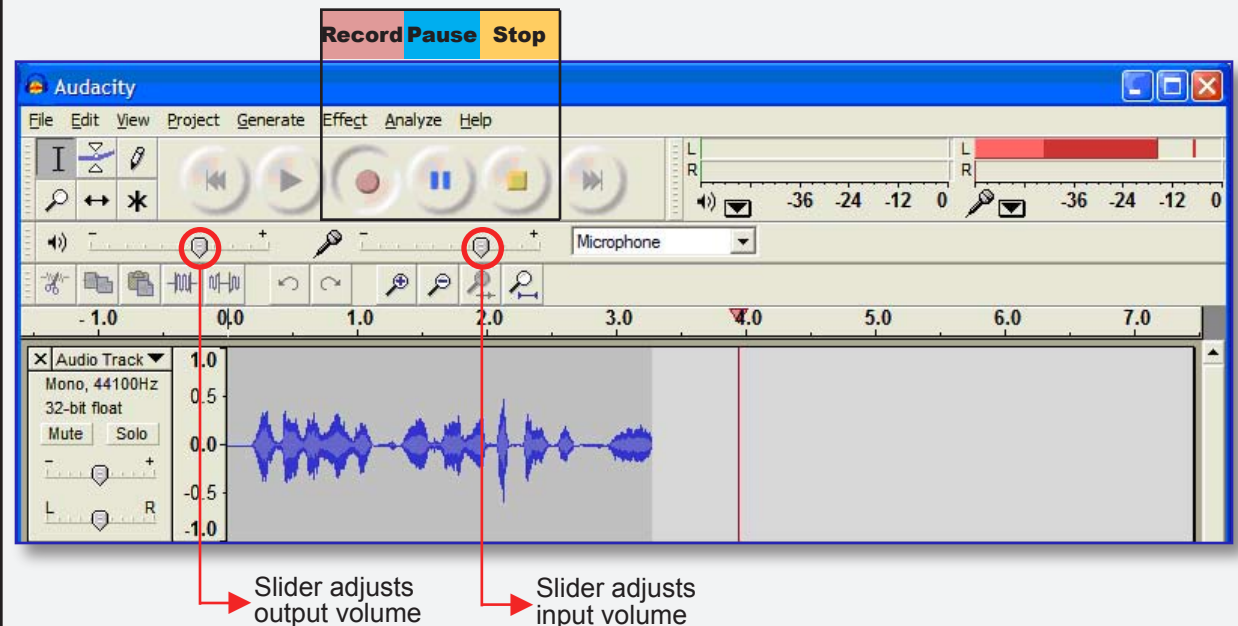
The Audacity recorder looks and operates very much like the handheld recording devices you are familiar with: Red for “Record,” Blue for “Pause” (click again to resume), and Yellow to “Stop.” It is important to note that a recording can be saved only after clicking the yellow Stop button.

The first slider adjusts the output volume during playback. The second slider adjusts the input (microphone volume) during recording.

Operations

1. Press **red** button to begin recording.
2. Press **blue** button to pause.
3. Press **yellow** button to end recording.



Note: Your recording can be saved only after clicking the yellow stop button to end recording.

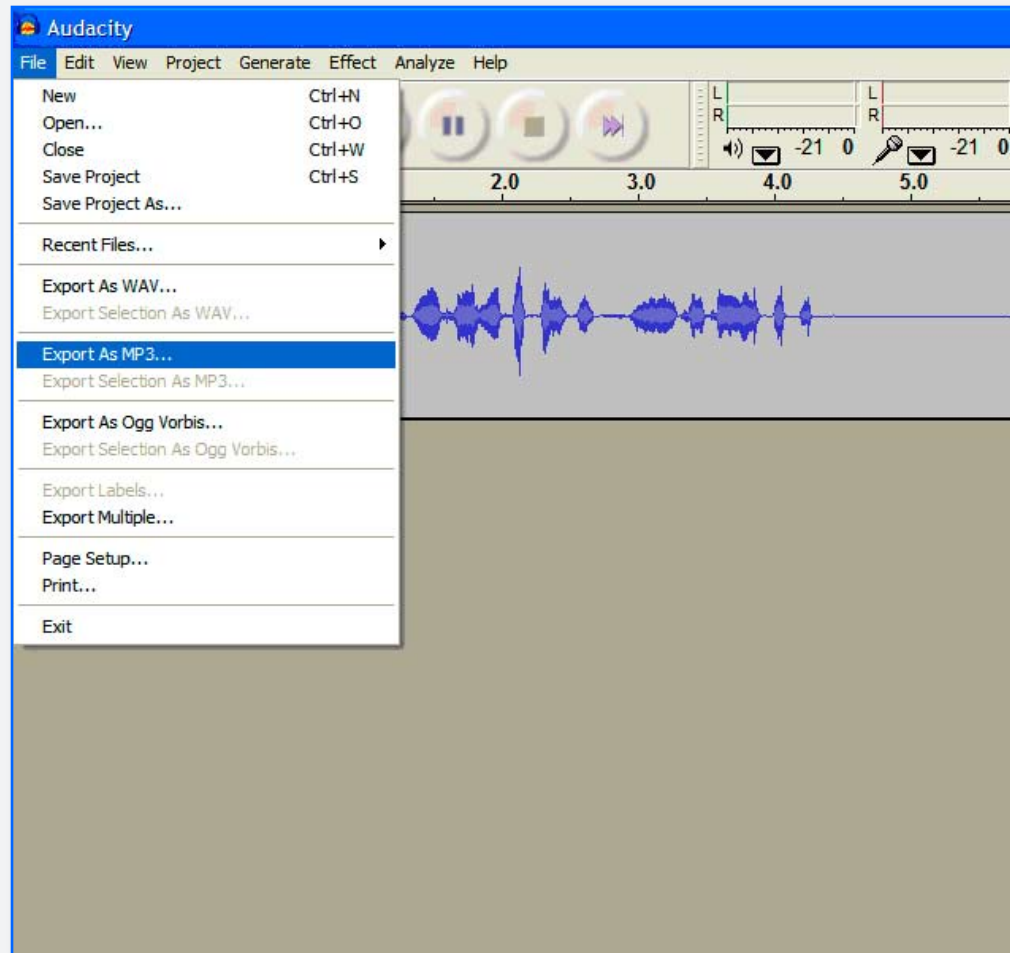
To save your recording, click the yellow **STOP** button.

Then go to the File menu, click and pull down to **Export as MP3**, click and release.

To Save Your Recording

1. Press **yellow** button to stop recording.
2. Go to File > Export as MP3

In the Save dialog box that appears, type in a name for your recording. In the Save Dialog Box's dropdown menu, select the location where you will store the file.

Then click **Save**.

The next dialog box adds optional identification information to your MP3 file that pertains to a musical recording. You can ignore this.

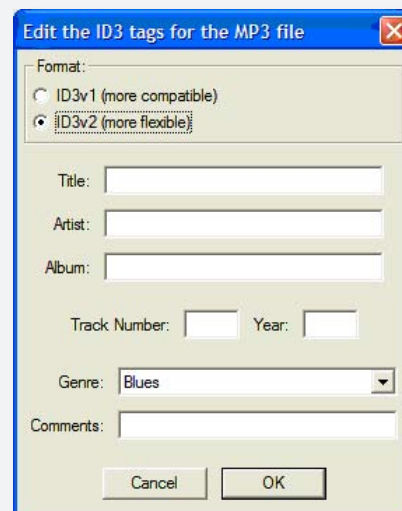
Click **OK**.

3. In the Save dialog box, type in a file name. Select storage location from dropdown menu.

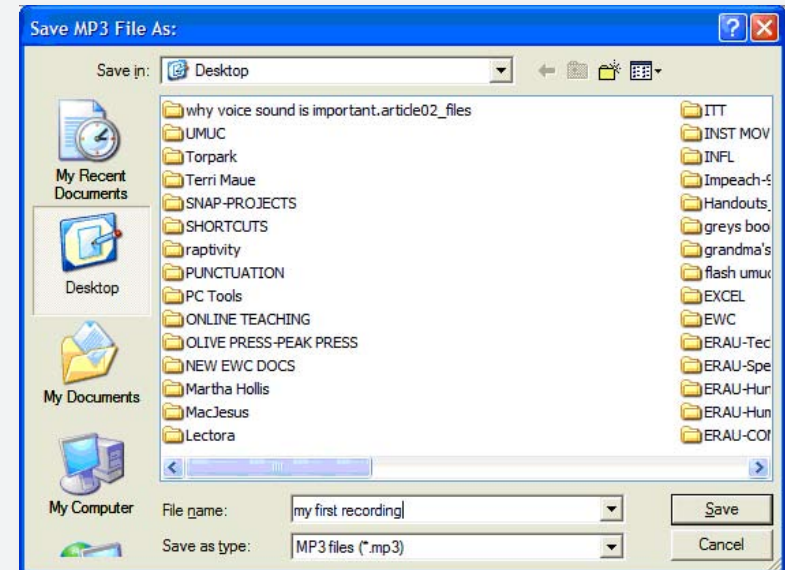
4. Click **Save**.

HOW TO USE AUDACITY TO CREATE MP3S

After clicking OK, you will see the MP3 file logo and file name on your desktop or the location where you saved the file.

Double clicking on the file will open and replay your recording in your default media device, *e.g.*, Windows Media Player, Real-Player, etc.

You can edit your recording in Audacity. Open the Audacity program, go to the File menu, then select Open. Then navigate to the MP3 file and double click to open it in Audacity. You can then use Audacity's Edit tools to delete, add, record over and make other changes to your recording.

The next video in this series will demonstrate how to create your personal account on UMUC's Polaris server, where you will upload your MP3s so that you can link to them in your advice templates.

The final video will demonstrate how to use a voice-recognition tool, DragonSpeak, so that your audio commentary will also produce a word-processed advice template with minimal typing on your part.
