Steps

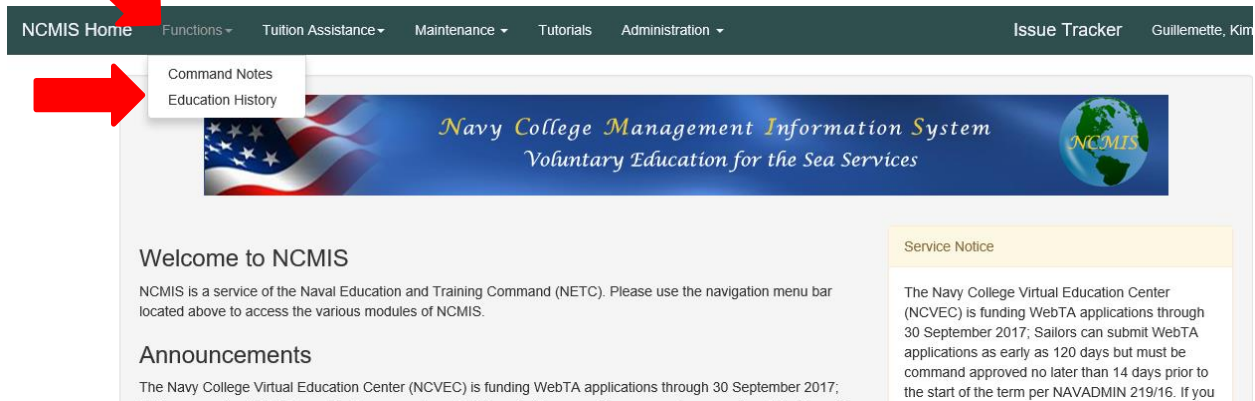
Prior to starting the tutorial personnel will be well versed in current policy.

 - Log into Navy College Management Information System (NCMIS) Modern

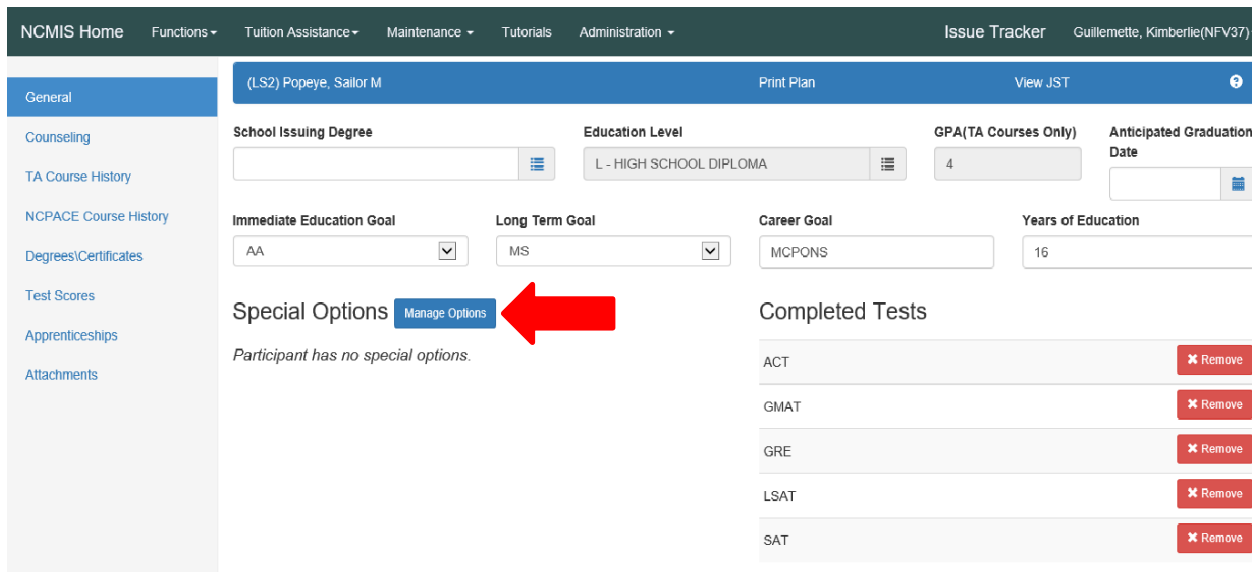

- Click on “Functions”, then “Education History”



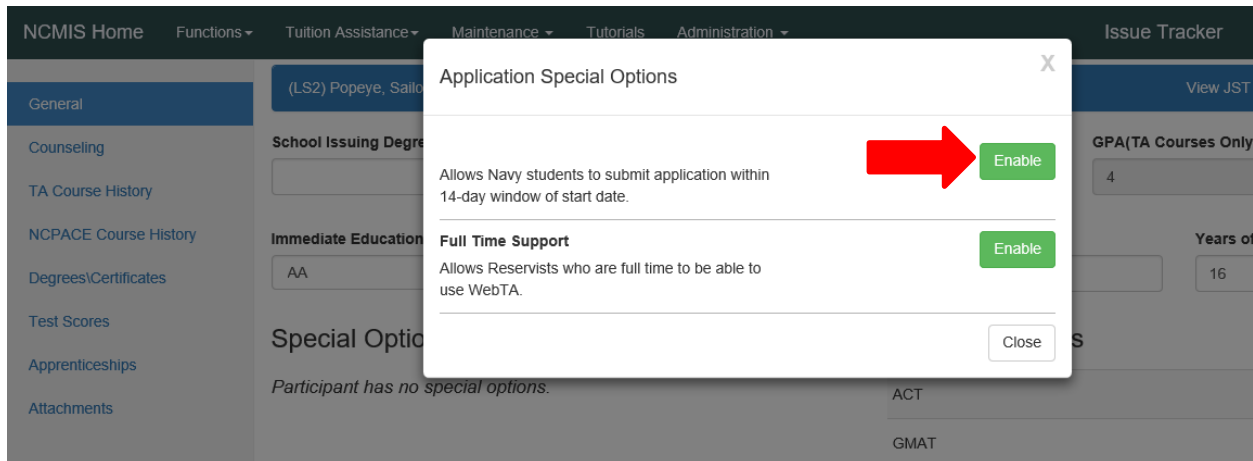
- Click “Manage Options”



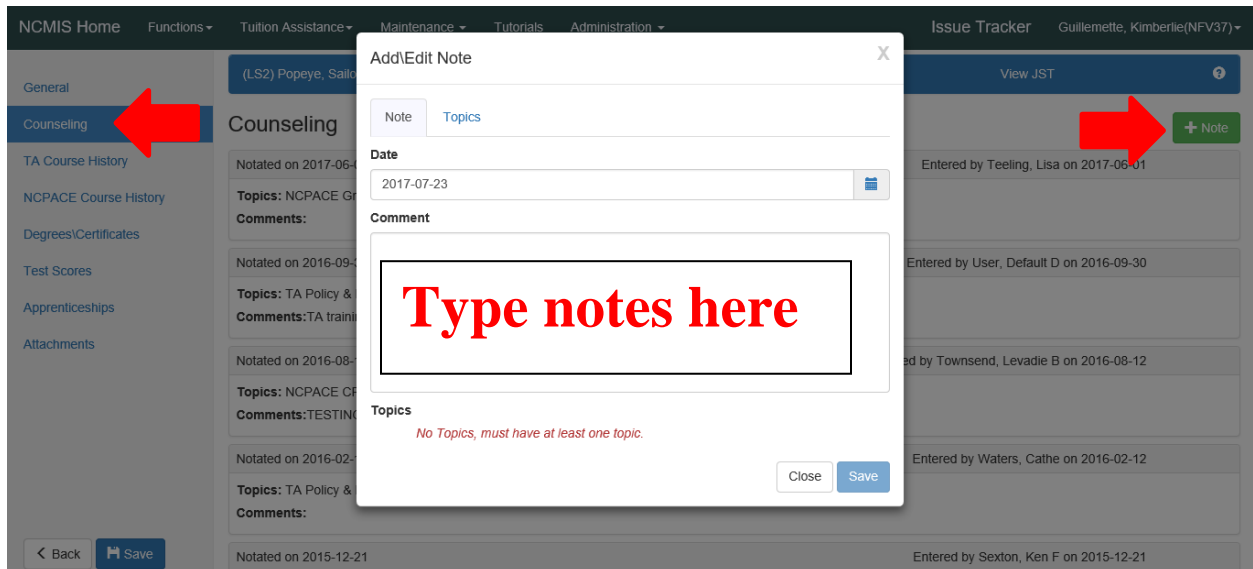
- Select “Enable” from the Application Special Options for the 14 day window access and close the pop-up window

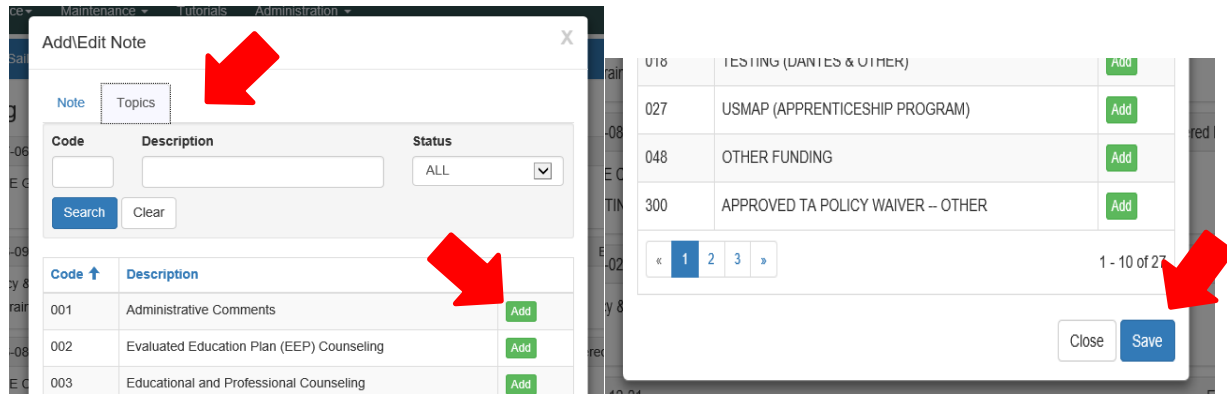
- Step 3: Document the record
